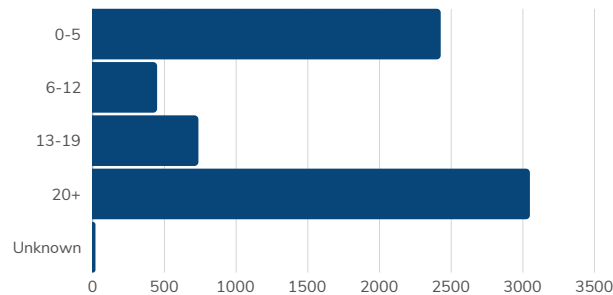
How We Work

- The Sanford Poison Center contracts with the Minnesota Regional Poison Center to manage all poison-related calls



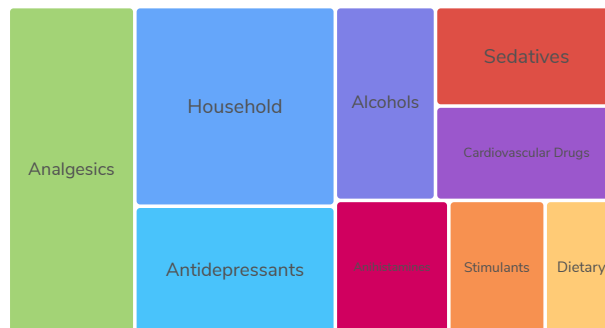
EXPOSURES BY AGE

Poisoning affects all ages, with over 90% of incidents occurring at home: children <6 account for half of unintentional, while teens and adults face higher risk for intentional, severe, or fatal poisonings.

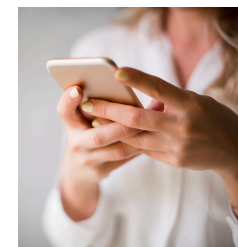


TOP 10 SUBSTANCES
